### 8. Infrastructure

The college covers an area of 2052 square meter. ensures optimal allocation and utilization of the available Teaching-Learning facilities by holding regular meetings of various committees constituted for this purpose as per the requirements in the interest of students. The college premises have twelve spacious, air-conditioned classrooms with Smart Boards & LED / LCD projectors and two tutorial rooms. There are four computer labs with the latest configuration with 30 computers in each lab. The library is well-stocked and digital. The availability of Plush Auditorium and Conference Rooms enhances the learning facilities for the students. Besides Smart Classrooms we have IT labs to learn the existing software processes.

The entire campus is wifi enabled with 100 Mbps Fiber leased line as backbone and secured with CCTV cameras & fire alarm system. There is a separate common room for boys and girls each with indoor games, gym and practicing for various events. There is also medical treatment room for administering first aid and Tie-up with Hospital for emergency medical aid. Exclusive Girls Hostel facility is provided in Kalkaji. The campus also has a well-staffed and equipped canteen as well as Nescafe corner for serving nutritious food.

There is facility of ERP with Provision for student's login, communication with faculty for assignments, case studies and lectures, online attendance, Dissemination of Notice & Circulars, Emails and Birthdays notifications is available on ERP.

For approx 720 students divided in 12 sections for all programs, there are 06 classrooms and one tutorial room as per GGSIPU & AICTE norms. In addition to this we have a plush seminar hall, conference room and GD/PI room fitted with all suitable amenities for conducting various curricular activities for students.

Area of Land(in Sq Meters) 2052.000 and Total Built-up Area (in Sq Meters) 4124.000.Total Built up Area Required as per norms for all programs 3421.200. We have sufficient built up area as per norms. For learning to work as a team, to inculcate competition spirit; sports help students build a strong character and a well-rounded personality.

The college ensures optimal allocation and utilization of the availability of physical facilities such as Boys and Girls Common Rooms with Table Tennis and indoor games (Chess, Carom) and Gym Equipment and Yoga facilities for doing yoga. The institute has a basketball court and badminton court.

Out-door sports stadia are hired for field games such as Kabaddi, Volleyball, Handball, Cricket and holding various sports competitions. The Sports activities are organized for both students and the alumni batches of the campus.

Co curricular activities meaning are more focused upon cognitive aspects thereby help in intellectual development, competitiveness, excellence, quality; achievements, creativeness and enthusiasm are few of the ethics of extracurricular activities.

We are organizing various cultural events regularly such as Zest and Dandia which is an intra JIMS Cultural festival. Anugoonj (IPU cultural festival), Star Night (inter campus cultural festival). The indoor auditorium with 130 seating capacity is used for organizing intracampus events such as Yoga day, Ad mad show, radio jockey hunt, antakshari, JAM, Singing and dance events

We have open space earmarked for doing activities to accommodate around 200 students.

### **LIBRARY:**

The college library has a huge collection of various kinds of documents, including books, journals, magazines, project reports, compact discs, solved question papers, best answer sheets, and other materials on a variety of topics that collectively support the teaching and other extension programs. Via the library management system "LIBSYS," which also gives users access to the library's online catalogue, the library has automated all of its routine tasks. The library offers a variety of amenities and services, such as book lending, reference, document delivery, photocopying, and material interlibrary borrowing through DELNET. The library features four networked PCs connected via LAN and is completely Wi-Fi equipped, making it easier for users to access electronic materials. Students can study at the library, which also offers a great setting for research. Students can easily conduct research, complete their tasks, and assess the degree of plagiarism in their written work by using computers and electronic resources. The library is automated using LIBSYS software. The programme is now at version Web Centric Lease. The current system, which is fully automated, since 2005. It creates a setting in the library that is very user-friendly. Journals and books: The library includes a substantial collection of books on all aspects of management, information technology, and mass communication, written by both Indian and foreign authors.

To make it simple for students to find the books they're interested in, every book in the stack area is arranged according to subject. A large number of journals are available in the library to support services for fieldwork and study. It offers web-based services that give users access to electronic books, journals, and research databases. A single point of access provides access to thousands of electronic resources. DELNET includes The College Library as a member.

As a result, users at JIMS Library have access to databases maintained by DELNET. Newspapers The JIMS Library subscribes to 14 significant daily newspapers, which are available for reading in newspaper stands. OPAC: Online Public Access Catalogue, enables users to find books by author, title, subject, classification number, and publisher. This also offers details on the status of the books that are currently on hand at the library. Course Guide, all course manuals offered by JIMS are kept in the library. The course manual includes the semester's syllabus as well as lesson plans, assignments, test questions, case studies, and other materials that serve as guidance for the lecturers. The college library provides the facility to use the library in the form of Digital library by using the computers kept there.

The JIMS library has huge collection of books, journals and magazines. It has 23683 books, 5882 Reference Books, 44 e-books, 144 Journals, 54 e-Journals, 03 Digital Database, 1026 CD & Video.

### **ICT- Enabled Facilities:**

All classrooms at JIMS campus are spacious and air-conditioned with computers, Smart board, LCD/LED, Internet(wired & wireless) and integrated with audio-visual teaching aids for lectures, presentations etc. They provide the most conducive atmosphere for dynamic and focused discussions. The college has 212 computers with 4 computer labs. There are 20 Projectors, 17 Printers, 3 Scanners, 78 UPS, 25 Switches, 29 Wireless, 35 Headphones with mikes, 6 Caller Mikes, 1 attendance machine, 3 amplifier, 4 wireless mikes, 1 podium mike, 3 wired mike, 2 TV, 2 DVD Player, 1 Fax Machine, 1 Photocopier, 2 Hand Scanner, 6 speakers, 8 smart boards, 1 logic keyboard & mouse. The Internet bandwidth upgraded to 30 Mbps in 2017-18.
