






### ANTI-FIRE CRACKERS PADYATRA

She highlighted the maximum people staying in the facility have some or the other nervous disorder and the most common among all is Alzheimer's and Dementia. After the guided walk, the resource person also narrated incidents of how ignored our elderly citizens are as children give up on their parents who are unwell and are no longer able to take care of themselves.








#### Tree Plantation
