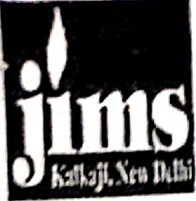


Workshop on Disaster Management and Desertification

EVENT REPORT

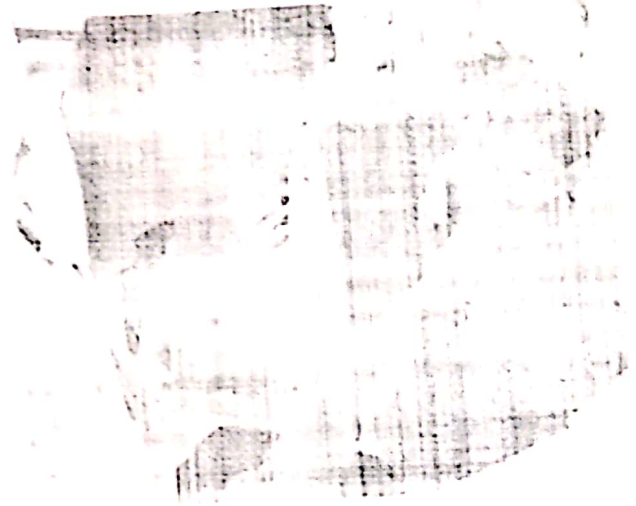
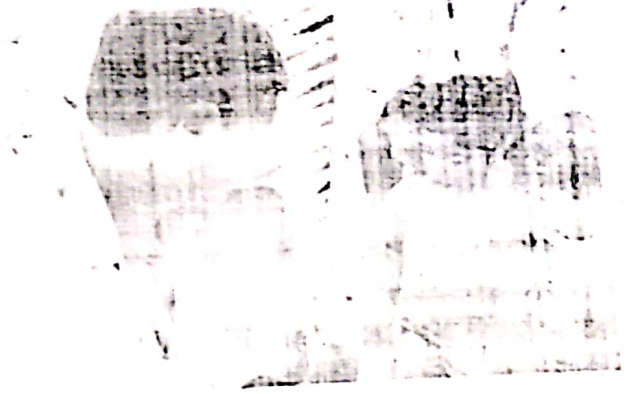
On 18/04/2019, a street play was organized by the members of Rotaract Club of JIMS, Kalkaji for the "Indradhanush Scheme" launched by the government of India. This play was presented in the streets of Kalkaji. In this play, students from BBA and B. Com(H) took part and gave their contribution towards educating the society.

The students included the main purpose and meaning of the "Indradhanush Scheme" in the play i.e. launched on 25th December, 2014. This seeks to drive towards 90% full immunization coverage of India and sustain the same by year 2020. The ultimate goal of Mission Indradhanush is to ensure full immunization with all available vaccines for children up to two years of age and pregnant women.

The students also took the initiative of taking the underprivileged children to the doctor and getting the vaccination done for them. The doctor shared the information regarding the vaccination and immunization with the children and hence motivated them to complete the course of vaccinations.

The whole plan was successful as the scheme was advertised widely and people got to know about a new thing which will benefit them and their family in future.
