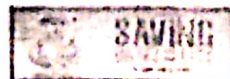
Rotaract Activity : Food Donation on Lohri & Makar Sankranti

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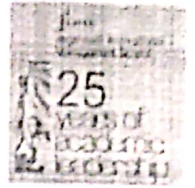

A group of 6 students along with a helper from the staff had gone near the temples of Kalkaji to donate the items collected by the College.

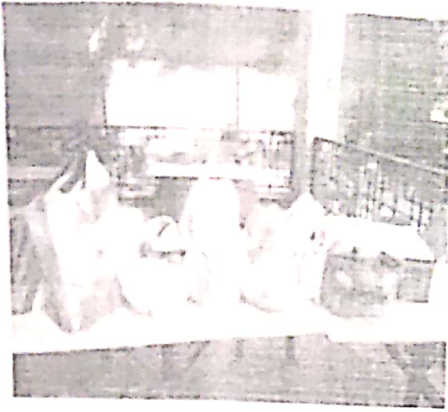
Learning Outcome:

2. It helped the students to connect with the ones who are less privileged than themselves and sense the happiness experienced by the people on receiving the food.

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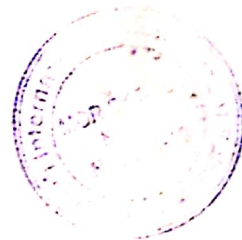

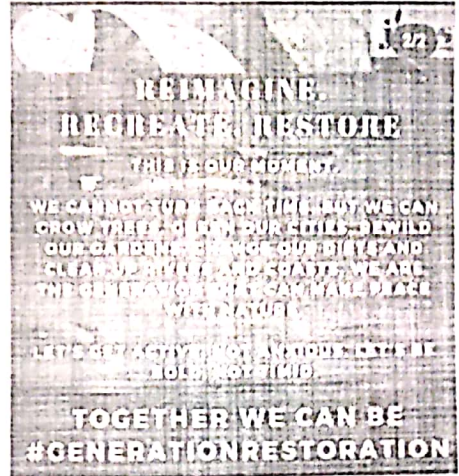
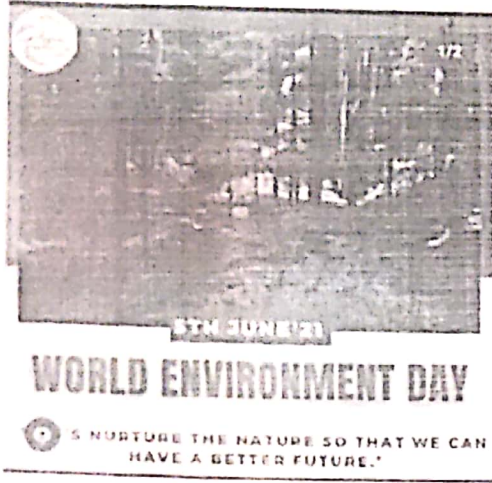
1. To celebrate Environment Day.
