3. Competition like lemon race was organized for children's and cash prize was given to winner



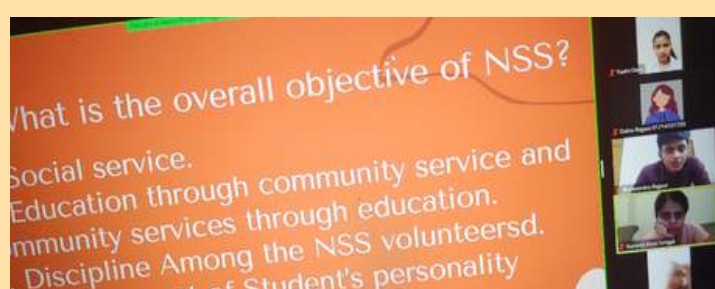
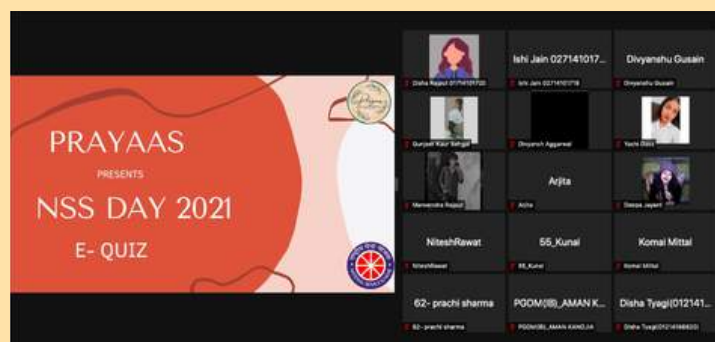
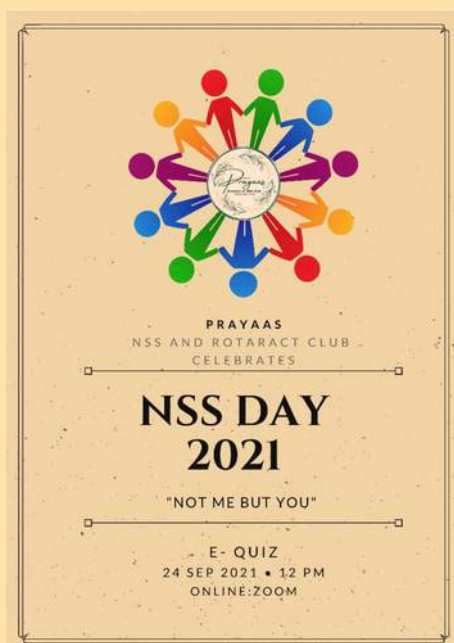
# NSS DAY

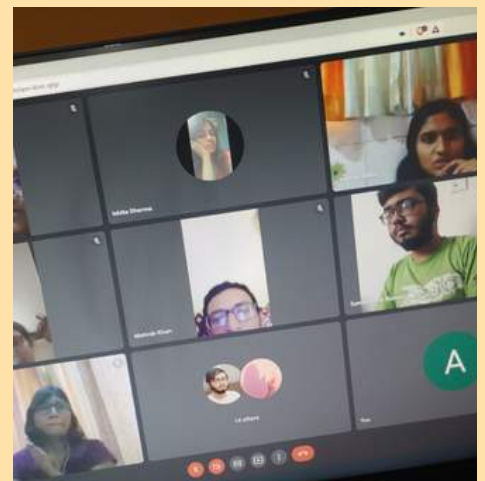
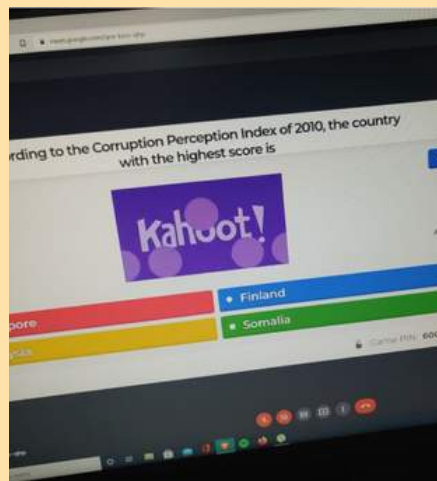
Event was conducted in Online as well as Offline Mode on 26th October 2021 at 11 a.m. on the portal.

First Runner up was Arnav Goel (SRMIST Ghaziabad)



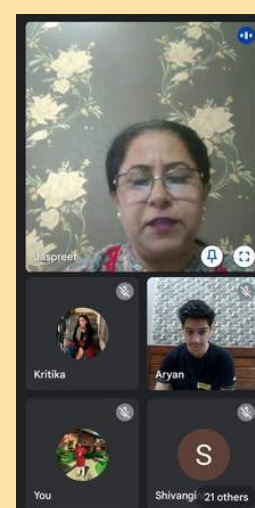
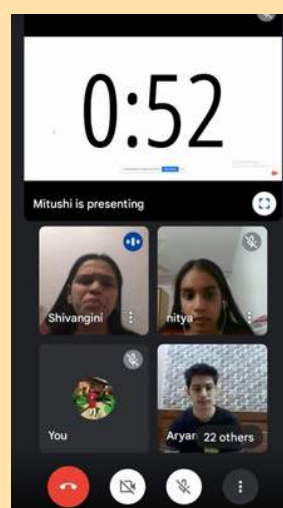
## JUST A MINUTE

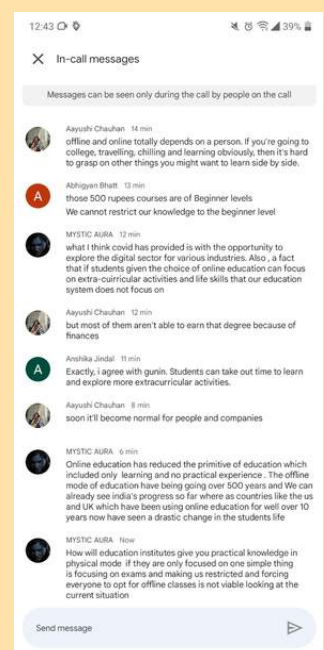
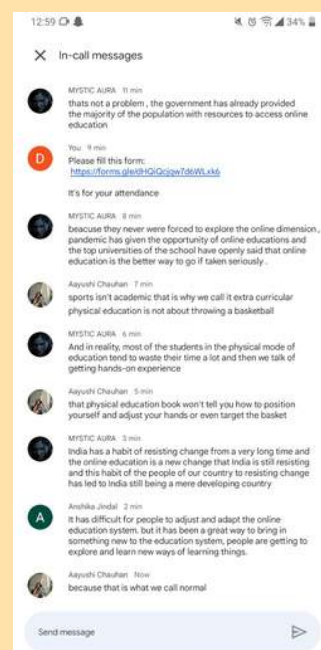
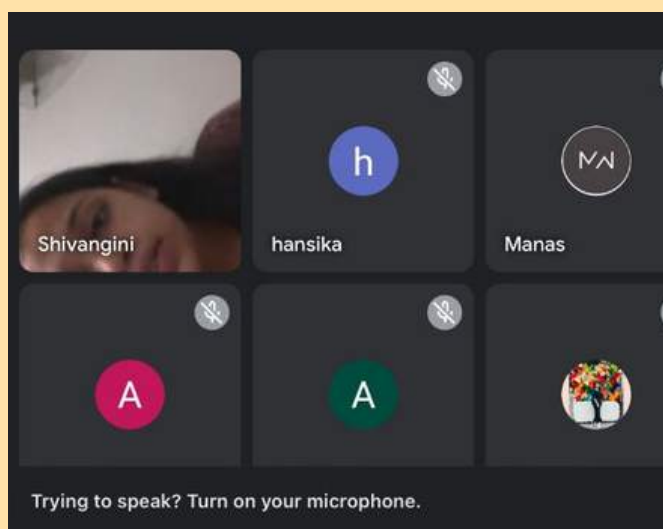
# GROUP DISCUSSION
