Event Report:

Jagannath International Management School (JIMS), Kalkaji successfully organized its 2nd National Conference on "Generative AI in Education, Research & Knowledge Economy for Viksit Bharat@2047" on 11th April 2026. The conference aimed to explore the transformative potential of Generative Artificial Intelligence in reshaping education, research ecosystems, and the knowledge economy in alignment with India's vision of becoming a developed nation by 2047.

The event commenced with the registration of participants at 9:15 AM, followed by the formal inauguration of the conference at the JIMS Auditorium. The ceremonial lighting of the lamp marked the official commencement of the conference, symbolizing knowledge and enlightenment. Dr. Anuj Verma, Director, JIMS Kalkaji, delivered the opening remarks, highlighting the growing significance of AI in driving innovation, enhancing productivity, and shaping the future of education and industry.

Following a tea break, the conference proceeded with **Technical Session I, conducted from 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM**. The session comprised four parallel tracks chaired by distinguished academicians:

A total 52 external and 26 internal registration received , 24 research papers were presented including external and internal registration (6 papers per track), covering diverse themes such as AI in education, data-driven research methodologies, digital transformation, and knowledge economy frameworks. Each presentation was followed by an interactive Q&A session, encouraging critical thinking and academic exchange. The conference proceedings was released on the day of conference published by Sharda Publishers with ISBN number 978-81-997124-6-1. Three best Paper was awarded viz first: Ms Bharti Sharma, Amity University, 2nd- Sweta Singhal ABS Noida, 3rd - Ms Sakshi Singh, Dr Tina Hassija, Dr Pooja Kapoor (School of Business Manav Rachna University) with award money as Rs 5000, Rs 3000, and Rs 2000 respectively

Post lunch, **Technical Session II** was held from 2:30 PM to 4:30 PM, continuing with the same track chairs. This session witnessed an even broader range of research presentations, focusing on advanced applications of Generative AI, including innovation in pedagogy, AI-powered research tools, ethical AI considerations, and the future of knowledge economies. The session reflected interdisciplinary participation and showcased innovative research contributions from scholars across institutions.

The conference concluded with the Valedictory Session from 4:30 PM to 5:00 PM, where Dr. Niti Saxena, Conference Convenor, delivered the vote of thanks. She expressed gratitude to all dignitaries, participants, faculty members, and organizers for their valuable contributions in making the conference a grand success.
