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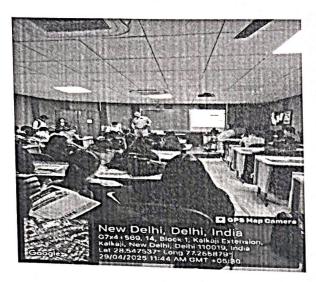
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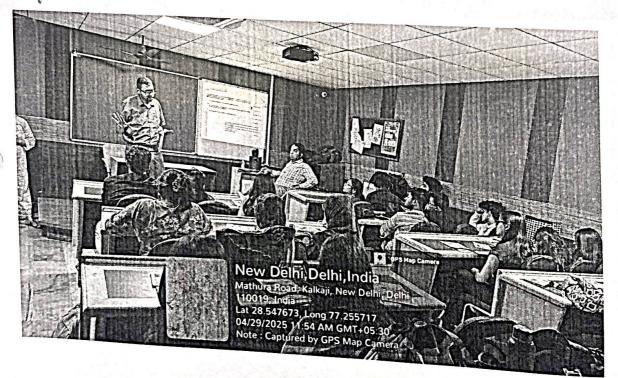

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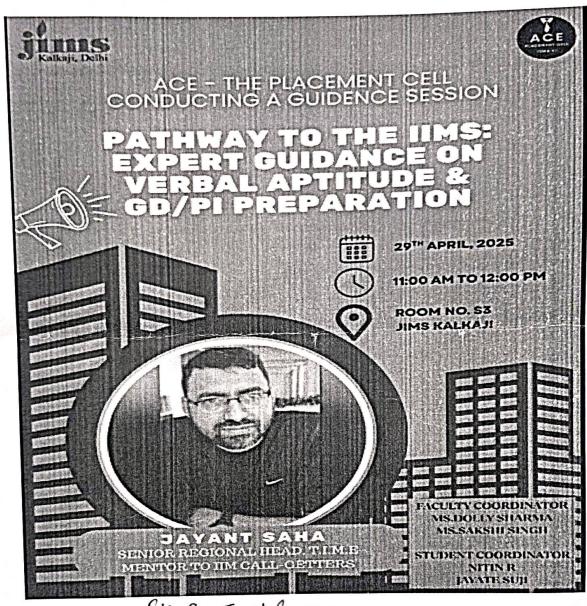

The session was graced by distinguished experts in the field of study abroad consultation:

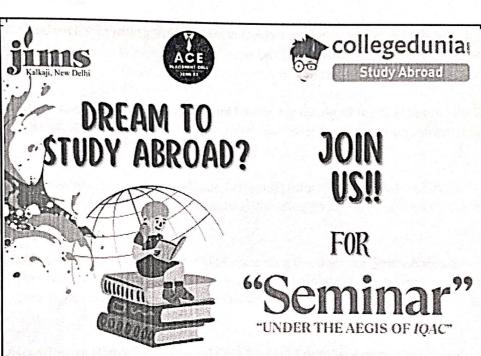

Overview:

ACE - The Placement Cell successfully organized an Ap tude Test aimed at assessing the analytical, logical, and problem-solving abilities of students. The test got enthusiastic participation from students, marking it as a crucial step in preparing them for upcoming placements.

The primary goal of the aptitude test was to familiarize students with the types of questions and challenges they might encounter during recruitment processes. It also aimed to help them evaluate their current skill levels and identify areas for improvement.

The test comprised sec ons on Quan ta ve Ap tude, Logical Reasoning, Verbal Ability, and General Awareness, designed to reflect real-world placement exam patterns. Participants were given 2 minutes for each ques on which is total 40 minutes to complete the test, with each sec on carrying 5 questions and equal weightage.

Performance and Results:

Out of 75 participants from different batches (1 st year, 2nd year and 3rd year) seven students scored 100% and average passing percentage is 72.9611%. E-Cer

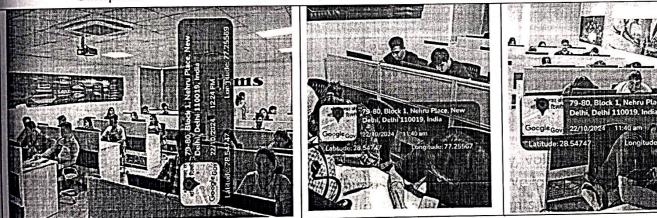

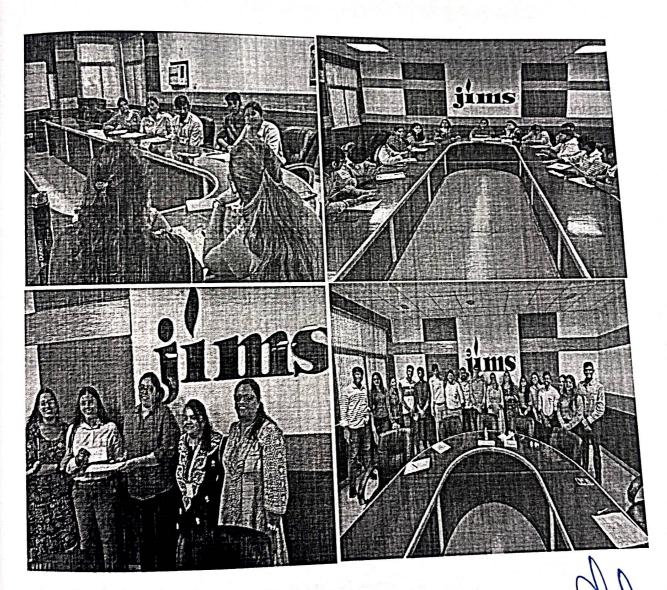
Report:

Group Discussion Overview:

Humane, the HR Club of JIMS Kalkaji, successfully organized the Verses of Verdicts- a Group Discussion Competition on the topic "Unpaid Internships- an Opportunity or Exploitation", began with participants being given 10 minutes to prepare their arguments on the topic. A majority of participants believed that unpaid internships often lead to exploitation, emphasizing that interns are frequently overburdened with labor-intensive tasks and responsibilities without any monetary compensation, making it unfair to students or freshers who invest significant time and effort without tangible benefits. On the other hand, some participants viewed unpaid internships as valuable learning opportunities, noting that many companies assign manageable workloads aimed at skill development rather than excessive labor. They argued that such internships serve as stepping stones to long-term career success by providing exposure, networking opportunities, and relevant experience for future job roles.
