The discussion commenced with Dr. Abhinav Akhilesh, Partner at Grant Thornton, who spoke about business transformation for sustainability, equal opportunities, the role of women in society, and initiatives like the Swachh Bharat Mission. Dr. Sudipti Arora, an Environmental Research Scientist, explored biotechnology's role in sustainability, delving into climate change causes and solutions through the AMG formula—avoiding, minimizing, and generating. 
