



### Report:

The Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on "Advanced Tools & Techniques for Research Methodology" was successfully conducted from 13th to 18th December 2024 at JIMS Kalkaji, the programme aimed to enhance the research skills and capabilities of faculty members across diverse disciplines. Objective:

The primary objectives of the Faculty Development Programme were:

- To familiarize participants with modern tools and software for data collection, analysis, and interpretation.
- To develop the ability to design and conduct systematic research studies across diverse disciplines.
- To promote the effective use of qualitative and quantitative research methods.
- To explore best practices for writing high-quality research papers and publishing in reputed journals.
- To strengthen skills in critically reviewing literature and identifying research gaps.
- To encourage interdisciplinary collaboration and innovation in research projects.

## **Event Highlights:**

Inauguration Ceremony

The program commenced with lightning of lamp and welcome address by Director sir and Heads of department who shared insights into the importance of innovative teaching and research methodologies in the rapidly evolving educational landscape.

Day 1: The first session of Faculty Development programme was conducted by Dr. Pushpendra Kumar, (Professor, Delhi university) on the topic "AI in Research Methods". Participants gained knowledge of AI tools and techniques applicable to research, learned how to integrate AI in various research stages, explored ethical considerations, and acquired practical experience. Second session was conducted by Dr. Neha Seth (Associate Professor, SOMS, IGNOU) on the topic "Quantitative analysis: Conducting bivariate analysis using EViews". Outcomes of above session was understanding Bivariate Analysis and Gained knowledge of analyzing the relationship between two variables.

Day 2: Both session of Faculty Development programme was conducted by Dr. Y.P Singh (Professor, Sharda University) on the topic "Structural Equation Modelingusing AMOS". Participants gained knowledge of Structural Equation Modeling (SEM) using AMOS (Analysis of Moment Structures) involves creating, estimating, and evaluating models that define relationships among observed and latent variables.

Day 3: Both session of Faculty Development programme was conducted by Dr. VipuleshShardeo (Asst.Professor, FORE School of Management, Delhi) on the topic "Modified Total Interpretive Structural Modelling". The outcome of Modified Total Interpretive Structural Modelling (MTISM) typically involves identifying and analyzing complex relationships among variables in a system.

Day 4 :Both session of Faculty Development programme was conducted by Dr.Ihtiram Raza Khan (Professor, Jamia Hamdard) on the topic "Use of Generative AI inResearch". The outcome of a session on the use of Generative AI in research is typically an enhanced understanding of how AI can assist in generating data, content, or hypotheses, improving research efficiency.


