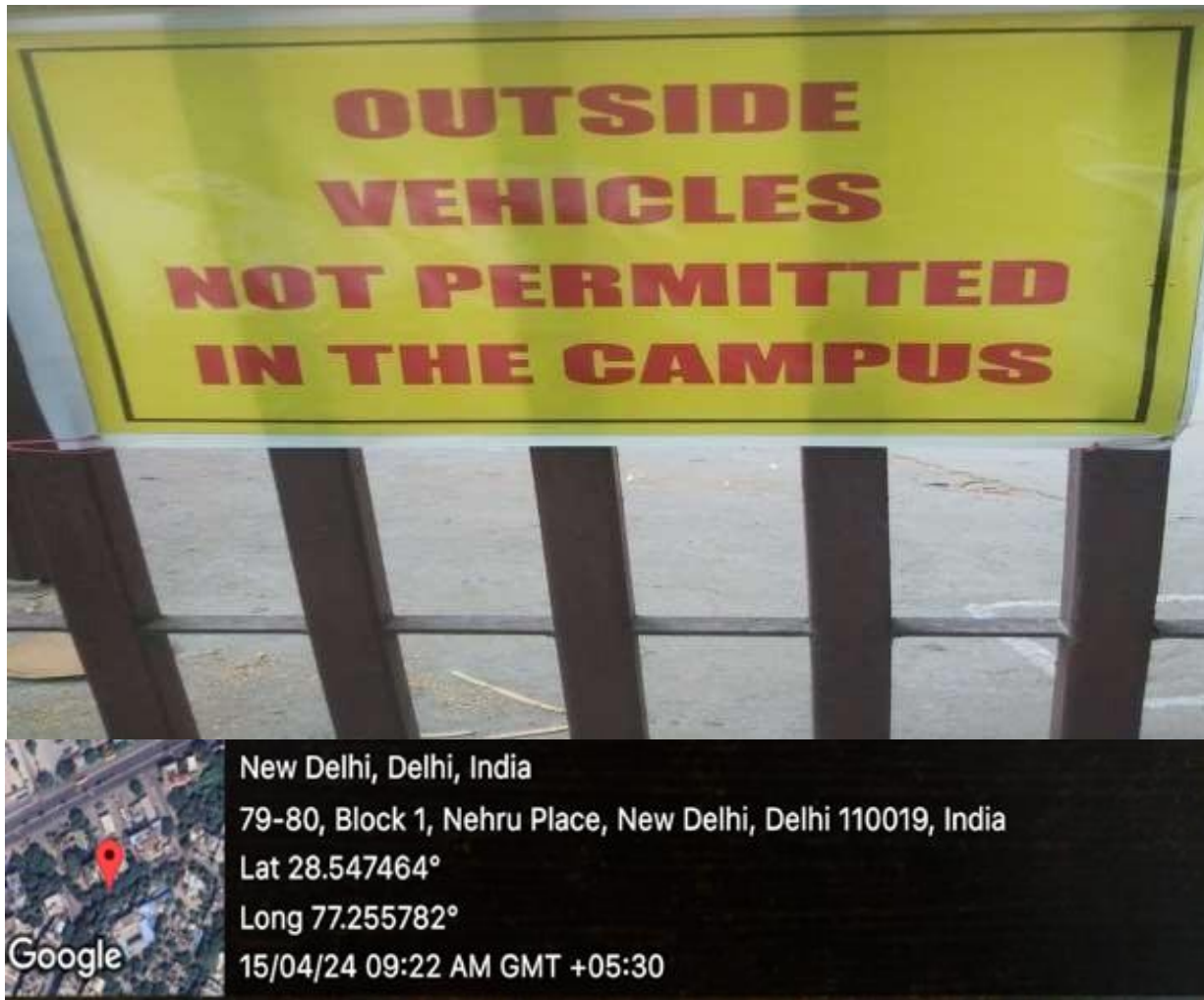

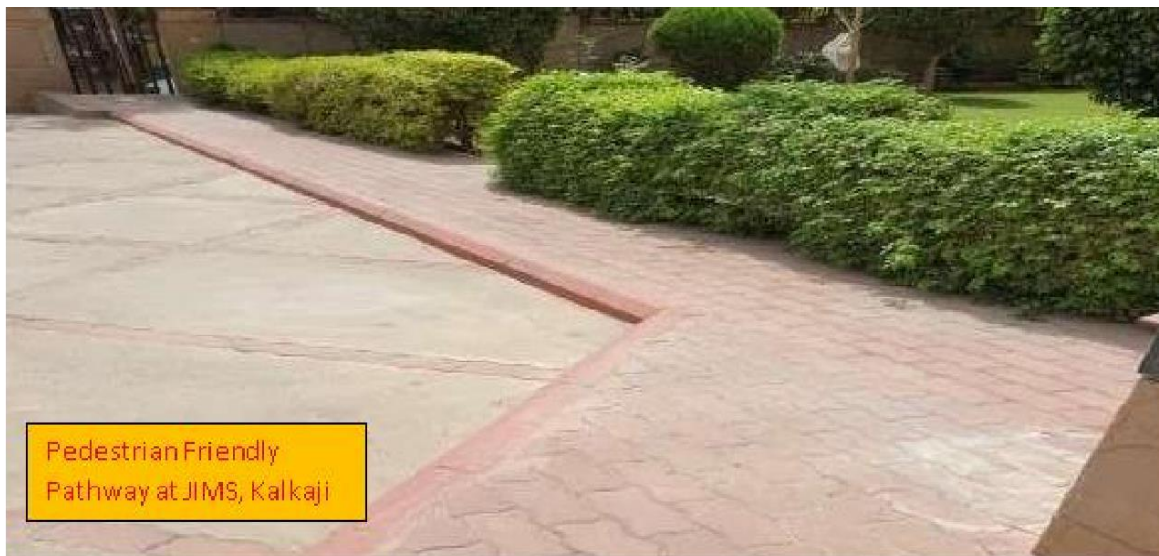
7.1.5 Green Campus initiatives

Why This Ban is Necessary:

These items are designed to be used once and discarded, but they take hundreds of years to decompose. The ban aims to promote the use of more sustainable alternatives, reduce waste, and protect our ecosystems.

Alternatives to Single-Use Plastics:

We encourage all residents and businesses to transition to eco-friendly alternatives such as:

- Cloth or reusable shopping bags
- Biodegradable or compostable plates and cutlery
- Paper or metal straws
- Reusable containers for food and drinks
- Glass, metal, or bamboo-based packaging

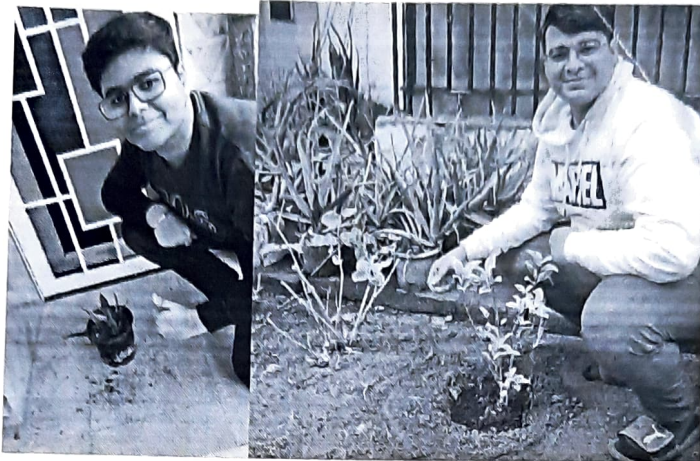

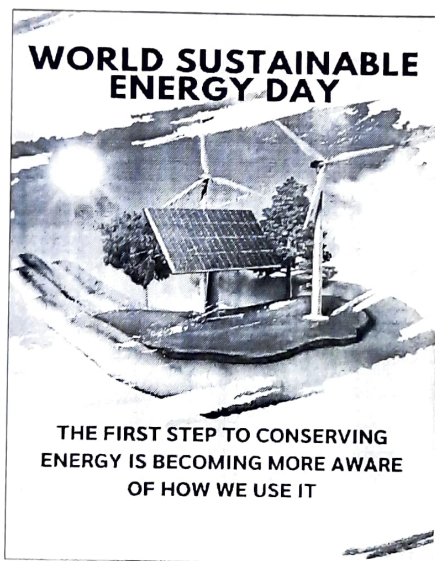
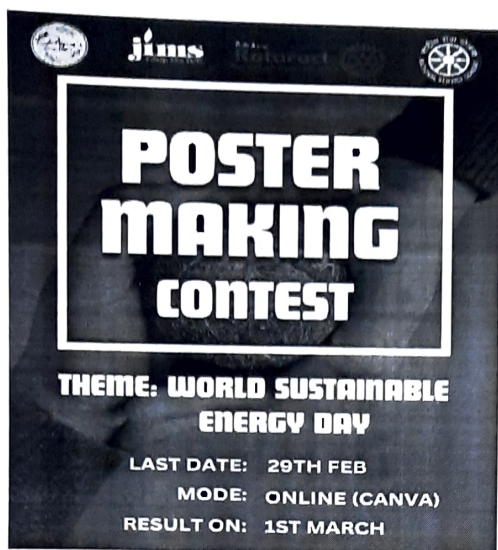
The contest aimed to raise awareness about sustainable energy practices and encourage participants to creatively express their ideas through poster art.



The objective was to raise awareness among the community about the harmful effects of plastic usage and encourage them to discontinue its use.

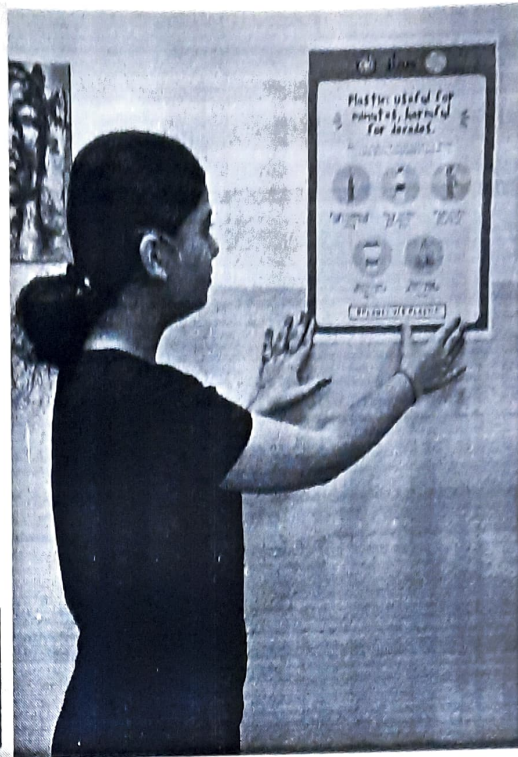
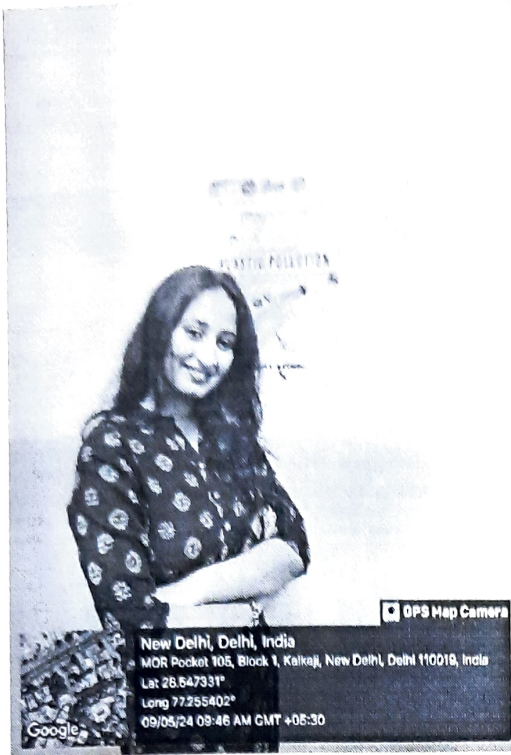
Report:

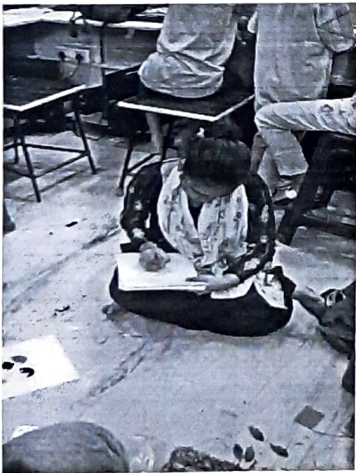
Report:
