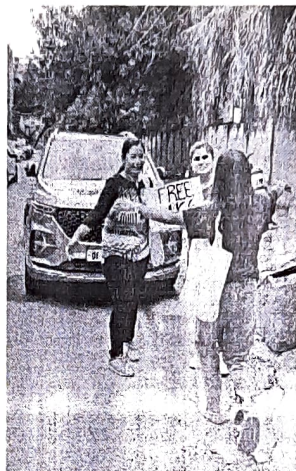

The blood donation drive proved to be a resounding success since a lot of volunteers came forward to this noble cause which would help in saving lives and benefit mankind in need.



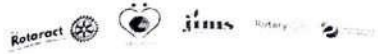
