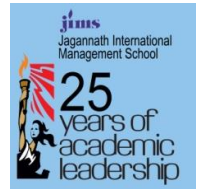

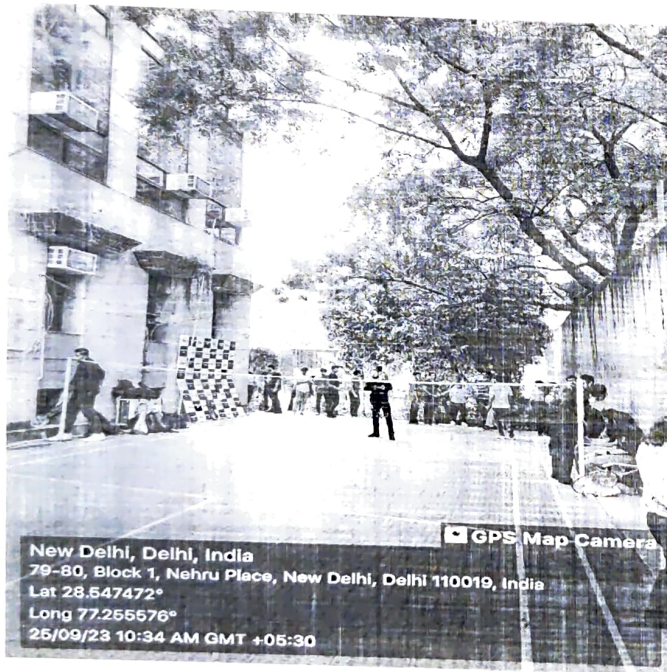


Figure 2:- Badminton Court

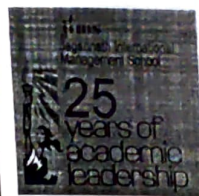

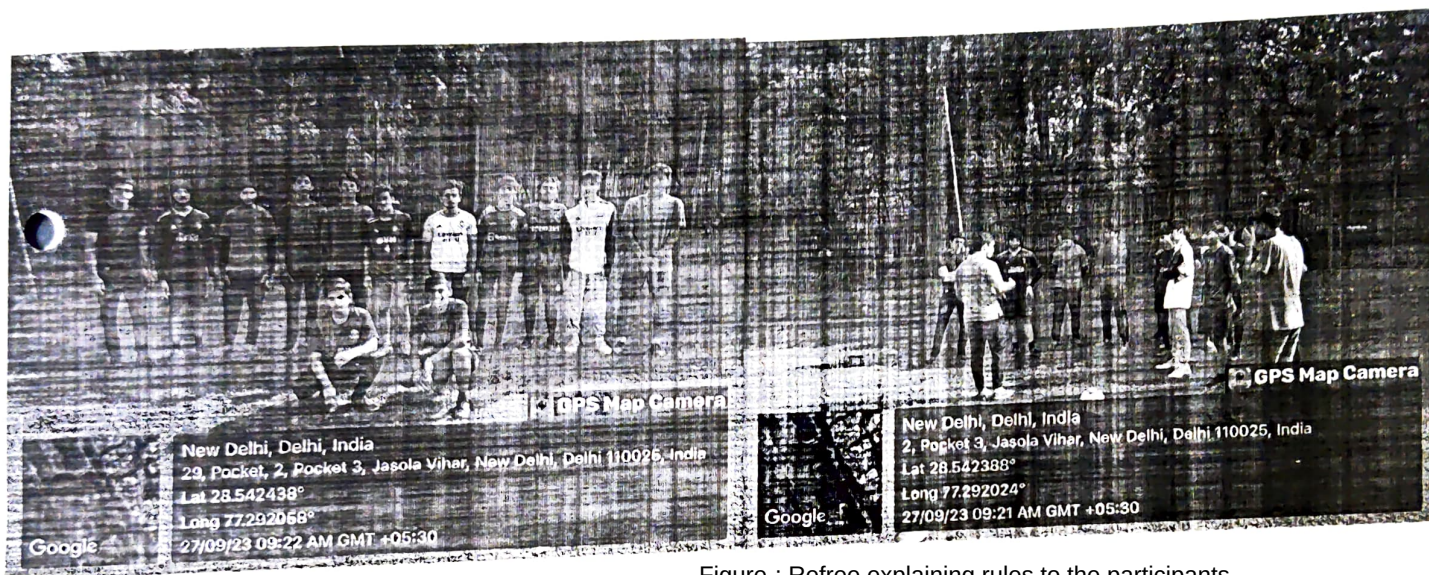


Figure:- Football Team

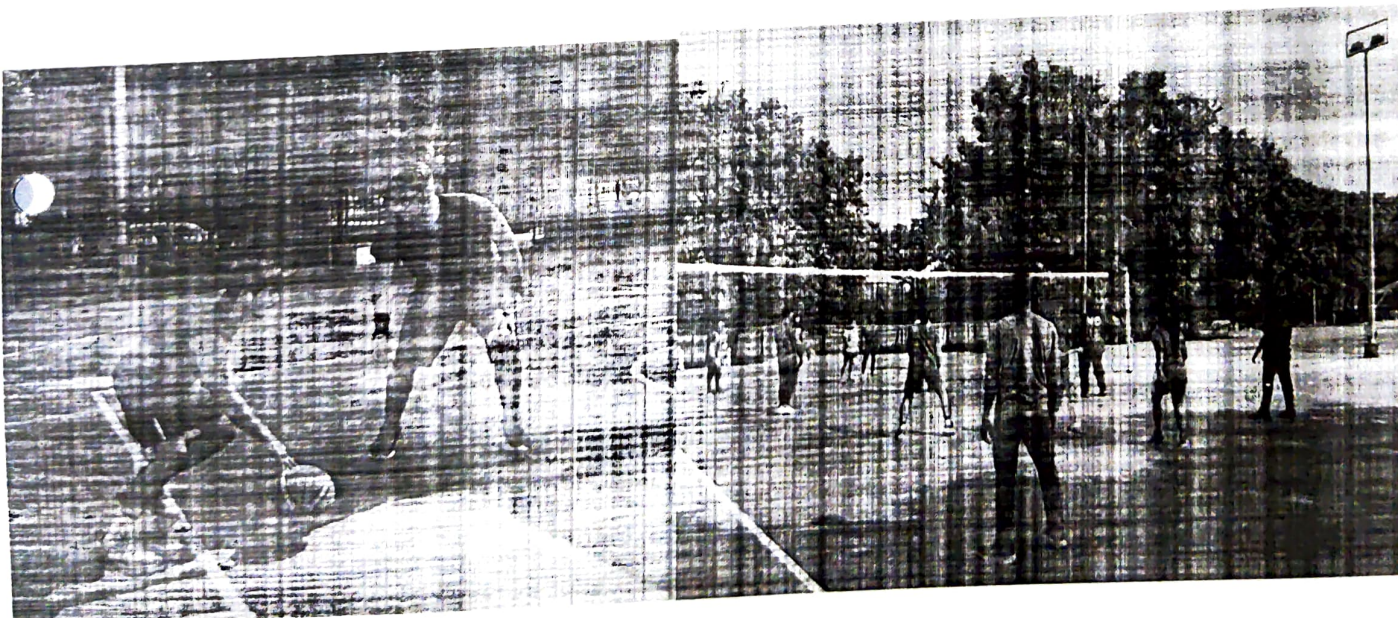


Figure:- Students playing football

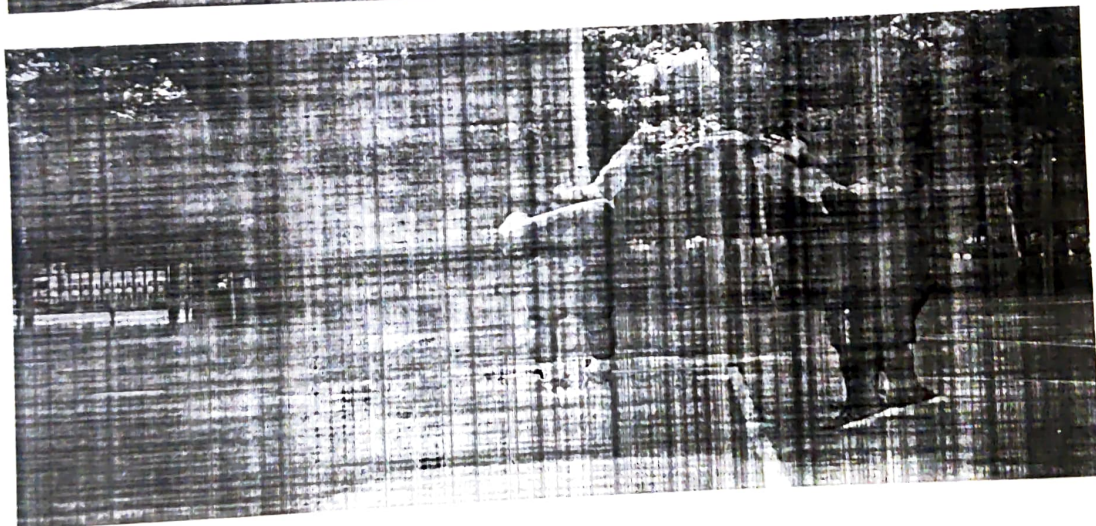
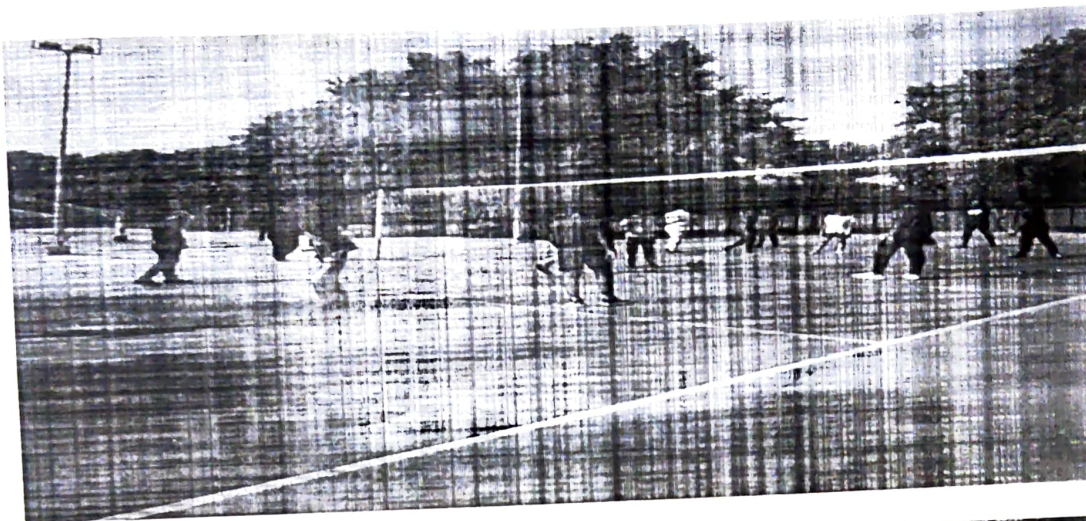

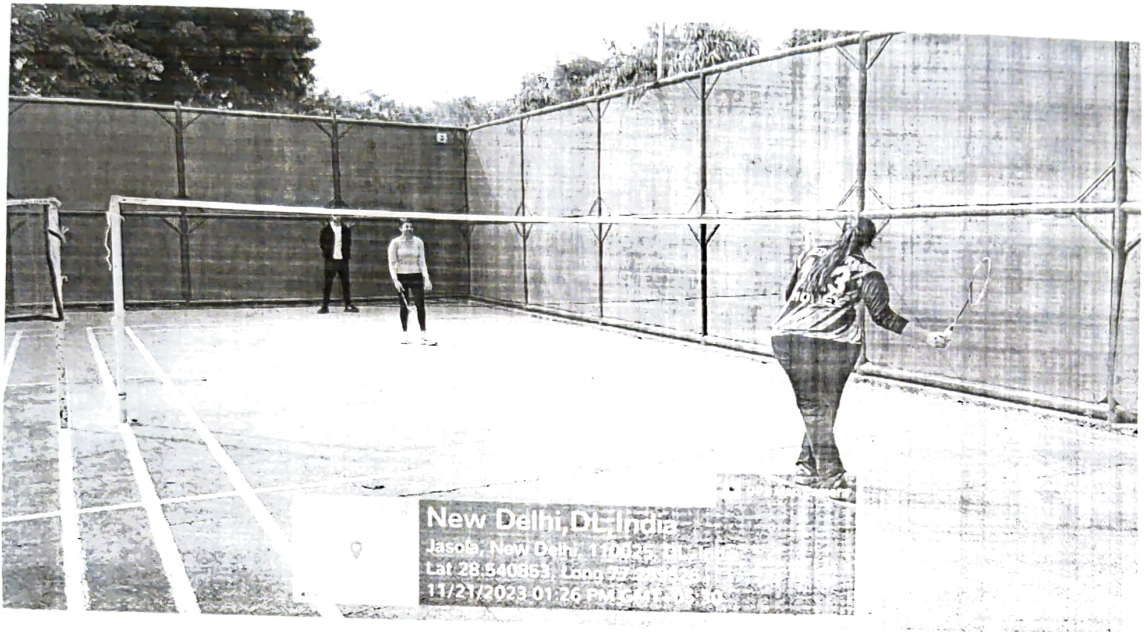


Figure:- Participants playing badminton

### **Report:**

they form the basis of vocal and instrumental training. This system of syllables was explained as a valuable tool for understanding and singing musical scales and melodies.

### 3. Tonic and Diatonic:

The concept of the "tonic" and "diatonic" scales was elucidated. The tonic was described as the foundational note or pitch upon which a musical scale is built. Diatonic scales, on the other hand, consist of seven unique notes within an octave, including the tonic, and form the backbone of most Western music. This knowledge was highlighted as essential for understanding chord progressions and harmonies.

### 4. Major Scale and Formula:

The major scale, a fundamental building block of Western music, was thoroughly explored. Participants were introduced to the specific pattern of intervals that defines a major scale (Whole, Whole, Half, Whole, Whole, Whole, Half) and its role in creating a bright and happy musical mood. The major scale's formula and its significance in melody and harmony were discussed at length.

### 5. Introduction to Ear Training:

Participants were introduced to the concept of ear training, emphasizing the development of their ability to recognize and reproduce musical notes, intervals, and melodies solely by listening.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

- Fundamental Music Concepts: Understanding music's definition, solfège (Sargam), tonic, diatonic scales, and the major scale and its formula.
- Ear Training Importance: Emphasizing the significance of ear training for recognizing and reproducing musical elements, enhancing musical skills, and fostering musical expression.

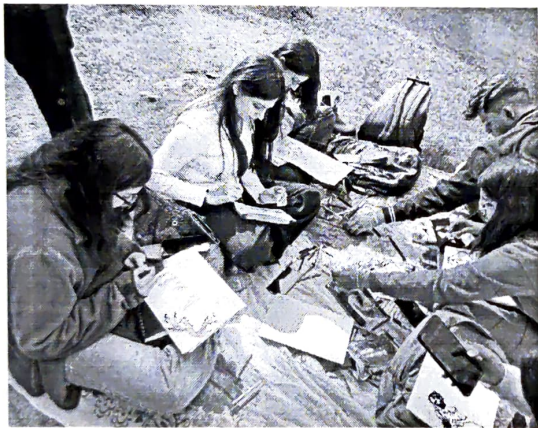
## **Report:**

SongQuest was a quiz organized by Qaafila – The Music Society of JIMS Kalkaji. There were a total number of 31 contestants, the participation was individual.

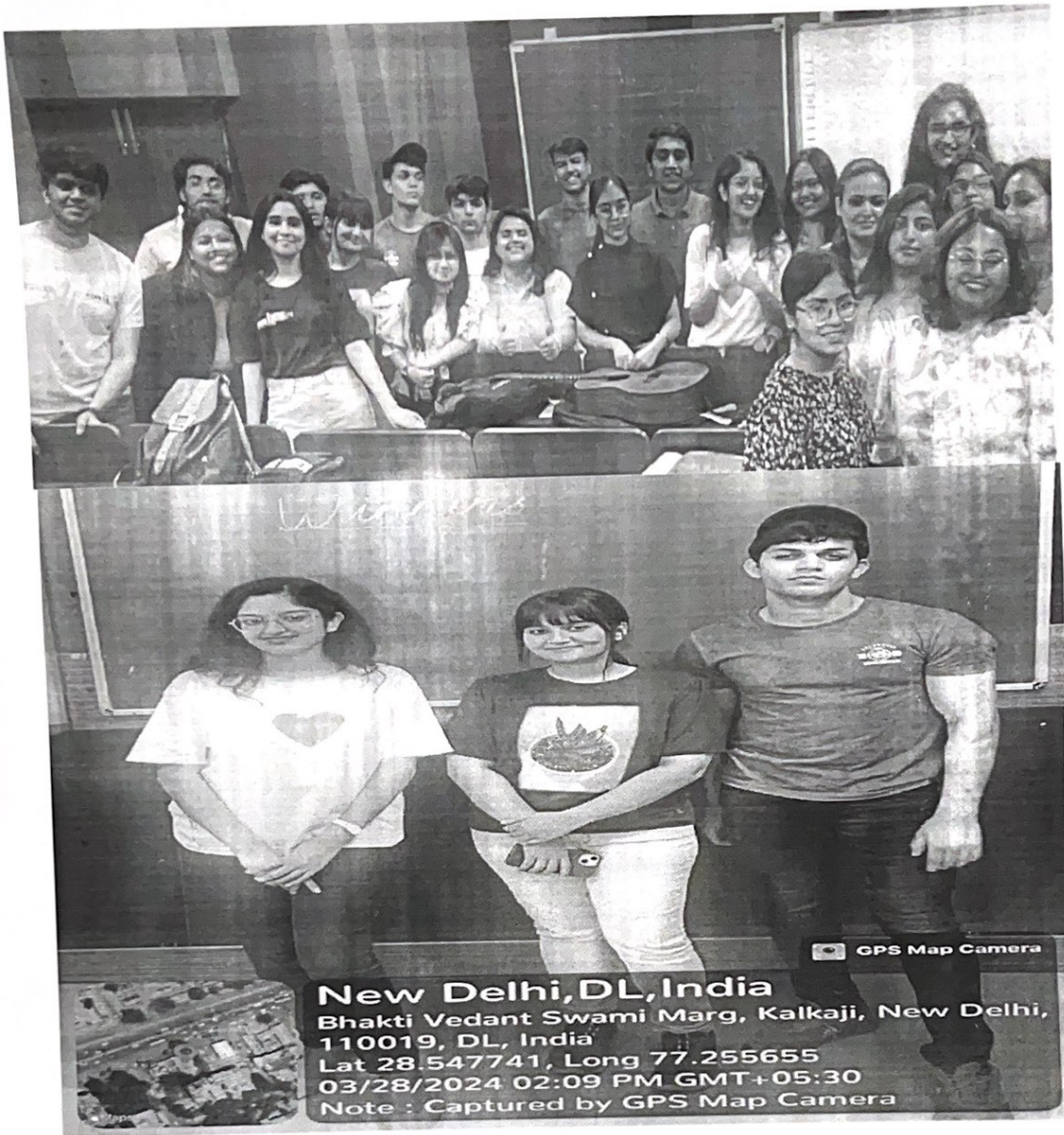
